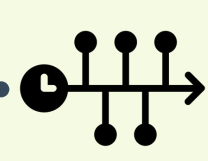

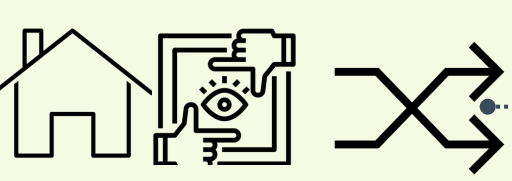
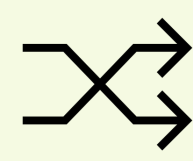

Children explore familiar situations now and compare and contrast to familiar situations in the past.

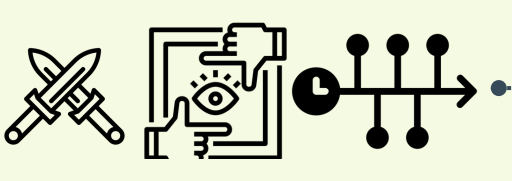
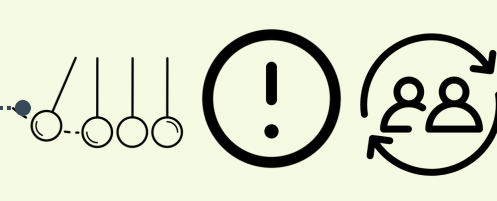

Children learn about the cause and consequences of Florence Nightingale's work in hospitals.

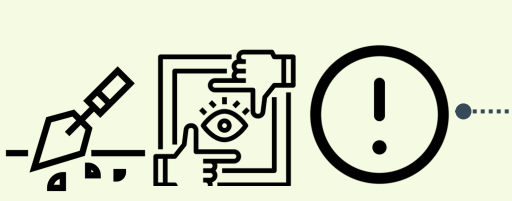
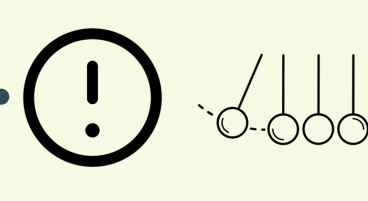

Children learn about him and the role he played in the historic event of the moon landing.

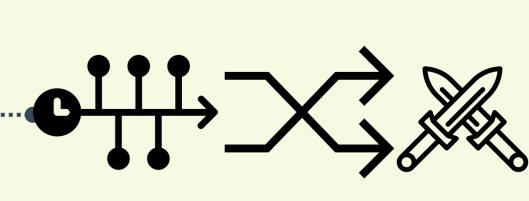

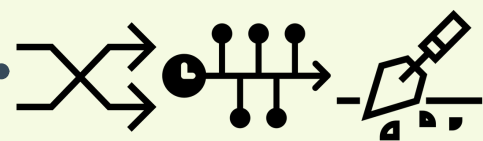
# HISTORY JOURNEY

Children learn about the achievements of one earliest civilizations -The Shang Dynasty.

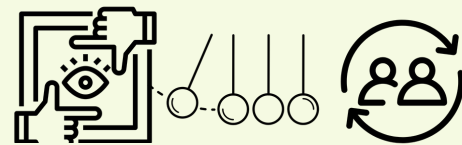

Children learn about Ancient Greek life, achievements and their influence on the western world.

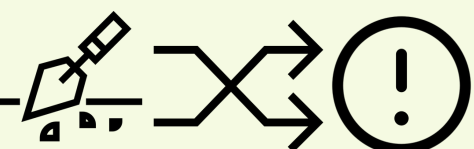

Children will learn about how Romans changed Britain and explore local history related to this .

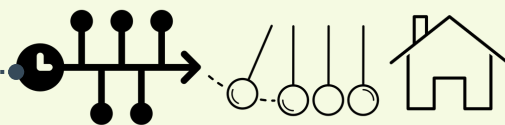

Children will learn about why and how Britain was settled, and eventually ruled by the Angles and the Saxons.

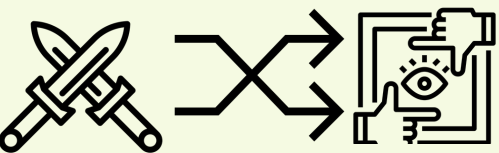

Children will learn a broad overview of the Viking conquests of different parts of Britain and the Anglo-Saxon resistance.

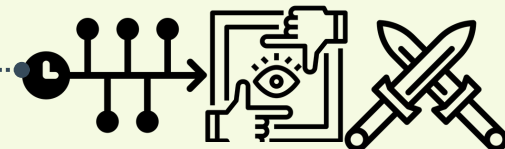

Children will learn about this west African civilisation and compare with the British kingdoms of the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings.

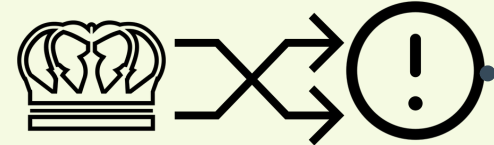

Children will learn about William the Conqueror, Henry II, King Richard and King John. They will also learn about the peasant, baron and the feudal system.

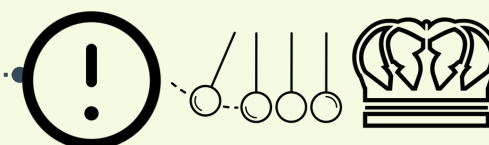

Children will learn about the Tudors and focus on local history of King Henry and the Mary Rose ship.

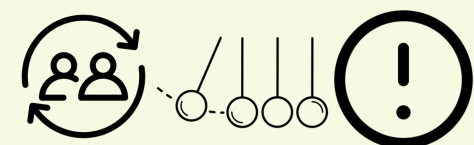

Children will learn about the industrial revolution and to its historical significance both within Great Britain, but also globally.

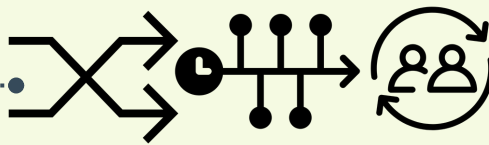
