### Year One Visit to Fort Nelson

To support our learning about Florence Nightingale Year One will be visiting Fort Nelson on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March or Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March. You will be informed by text which day your child is going.

During our workshop we will meet Florence Nightingale and learn more about her work to transform hospitals through storytelling and role play.

The children will leave school at 9.15am and will return at approximately 3pm. As this visit will include some walking please ensure that your child wears suitable shoes and has a waterproof jacket. It can be cold at Fort Nelson so layers are recommended under normal school uniform.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a named disposable bag including a bottled drink for the day. If you require a school packed lunch please let the office know by **Wed. 25<sup>th</sup> Feb.**

The cost of this visit will be **£5.50** per child and covers the cost of the workshop and transport. Please make payment and give permission for your child to take part in this opportunity on the Arbor app.

We will be inviting parent helpers on this visit, if you are interested in helping please inform the school office or Miss Knight and we will be in contact with you to give further information. Please note that due to limited seating on the minibus parents will need to travel with their child in their own transport but will not need to come to school first. You will meet us at Fort Nelson at 9.45am and be able to go home with your child at 2pm.
