We are so proud to be able to share the outcome of our recent Ofsted inspection with you. The report really captures what it feels like to be part of Meon Juniors – a welcoming, inclusive place where children feel safe, valued and supported to be their best selves.

Inspectors spoke about the care our staff show in understanding each child as an individual and the way pupils rise to high expectations with kindness, confidence and pride in their school. They recognised how well our children are supported to overcome any barriers to learning, and how positive relationships help them to grow into confident, independent learners.

This outcome belongs to our whole community. It reflects the hard work and dedication of our staff and governors, the positivity and resilience of our pupils, and the trust and support you show us as families every day. We truly couldn't do this without you.

While we are celebrating this moment, we also see it as a chance to keep moving forward. We are already building on this success, especially in developing pupils' writing and grammar, so every child leaves us feeling confident, capable and ready for what comes next.
