

## Further Details of Swimming Education

**Dear Parents and Carers,**

We hope you were delighted to hear the news that your child will be participating in swimming lessons during Summer 2!

A pop-up swimming pool is being installed at Moorings Way at half term. Full details of this facility and a set of FAQs regarding this facility have been given in the previous letter.



**On swimming days, please ensure your child brings:**

- A **towel**
- An appropriate **swimming costume**
- **Swimming hats and goggles** will be provided, but children are welcome to bring their own if preferred.

Lessons will be taught in **small groups of 10 or less** to ensure the best possible support and progression. All children will get changed inside the swimming marquee in individual changing pods. Your child's timetable can be found below, please make a note of the dates they are swimming.

You need to complete the **Swim Ed information form** regarding your child's current swimming ability if you have not already done so – this will help us tailor the sessions appropriately.

### **Timetable:**

As the pool is located on the Moorings Way site, we are able to offer swimming sessions in very small groups of 4–5 pupils for Team Attenborough. This will give each child an excellent opportunity to make real progress in their swimming.

During the first week, pupils will swim on either **Monday 1st July or Thursday 4th July**. Please ensure all pupils bring their swimming kit on Monday, as groups will be organised once all survey responses have been received. Pupils who are allocated to the Thursday session may leave their swimming kit in school until that day.

Once the groups have been finalised, we will send a further letter confirming each child's swimming day for the week beginning 8th June.
