Dear Parents and carers,

In Hedgehog Class we will be learning using sensory play experiences.

Sensory play provides valuable opportunities for children to explore different textures, colours, smells and tastes in a safe and engaging environment. These activities support the development of communication skills, curiosity, fine motor skills and sensory processing.

During these sessions, children may be exposed to a range of food items such as fruit, vegetables, pasta, cereal, rice, jelly and other suitable food products. Food will be used for exploration and play purposes and, where appropriate, may also be tasted.

In addition, children will be offered a snack during the school day. This will typically consist of fruit, breadsticks or biscuits, unless they have been provided with their own snack from home.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children, we ask that you provide consent for your child to participate in these activities. Please also ensure that the school is aware of any food allergies, intolerances, dietary requirements or medical conditions that may affect your child's participation in sensory play activities or snack times.

If your child's allergy or dietary needs have changed recently, please contact the school as soon as possible so that our records can be updated.
