Dear Parents and Carers,

A huge welcome to our school community. We are so excited for you and your child to join us!

You will have received your child's personalised timetable for this week. Your child will be attending school at the following times:

- **Monday:** 9:15am - 11:30am / 1:00pm - 3:00pm
- **Tuesday:** 9:15am - 11:30am / 1:00pm - 3:00pm
- **Wednesday:** 8:50am - 11:45am
- **Thursday:** 8:50am - 1:00pm
- **Friday:** First full day, 8:50am - 3:20pm

All children should arrive in full school uniform, with a book bag and a named water bottle. Please ensure that all items of uniform are clearly labelled with your child's first name and surname (or surname initial), as some children may have the same first name.

Your child does not need a pencil case or any stationery. We also kindly ask that toys are not brought into school.

Each morning, your child's teacher will greet you at the classroom door. Children will be encouraged to find their peg, hang up their coat and place their water bottle in the designated box. They will then have time to play and become familiar with the classroom that has been prepared for them.

At collection time, please come to the Year R area, where your child will be dismissed to you.

Lunches (Thursday and Friday)

If your child is having a hot school meal, please log in to Arbor (available from Monday) and order their lunch before they arrive on Thursday.

If your child is having a packed lunch, please ensure they bring a clearly named lunchbox to school. We recommend practising opening lunchboxes and containers independently before they start. To avoid children feeling overwhelmed, it can also help to talk through their lunch with them and only pack what is needed.

Staff will support your child during lunchtime, helping them where needed and encouraging them to eat as much as they can. Please remember to include a small drink or carton in packed lunches.

Please note that we are a nut-free school.

PE Kit

Your child will need to wear their PE kit to school every **Monday from 14th September onwards**. They will not need their PE kit before this date.

Thank you for all of your support during our transition visits. We hope that your child has a wonderful start to school. We look forward to seeing you all again and welcoming you to our Meon Way community.
