Stone Age Workshop – A Day of History in School

We're pleased to let you know that your child's class will soon be taking part in a **Stone Age Workshop** – a full-day, immersive history experience delivered here at school by **Historic Workshops**.

The workshop will give the children the opportunity to step back in time and experience **Stone Age life** through a range of practical, hands-on activities.
