Dear Year 4 parents,

As a part of our Rivers topic, we have the opportunity to visit the Chichester Harbour Conservancy Education Centre in **October**. Across the site, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a number of exciting activities. These include: completing field sketches and venturing into the stream to complete measurements of the water and banks.

The trip will run during the school day.

We will leave Meon by minibus at 9:00am and will return for normal pick up at 3:10pm - so children should be dropped off and picked up as usual.

What to wear?

On the day the children will need:

- A packed lunch and a water bottle
- Wellington boots (long boots would be best as we will be paddling in the river)
- A change of socks and shoes
- A good coat
- To wear their own clothes dress appropriately for the weather and the activities (we will be wading in the river and hiking!)

What to bring?

Their inhaler if they require one. We will not be visiting a shop so there is no need for money. As always, children should not bring any electronic devices - including phones.

If your child in entitled to a free school meal and would like a packed lunch please inform the school office as soon as possible.

The total cost of the trip is £9.25 per child. Please give permission for your child to attend and make the payment on the Arbor app by 2^{nd} October. Unfortunately, if sufficient money is not collected, we will be unable to run the trip.
