Dear Year 4 Parents and Carers,

As we head towards the end of our first term, we would like to let you know that we have some exciting trips planned for the early part of 2026. Currently this letter is for information, and payment facilities will be set up once the final details have been arranged.

Our first outing is an opportunity for the whole year group to attend a free performance by the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra at Portsmouth Guildhall. This visit will give the children a wonderful chance to experience live orchestral music whilst supporting their learning in the arts. This trip is planned for **22**nd **January 2026**, and we will be travelling by train from Fratton to Portsmouth and Southsea. We anticipate the cost to be around **£2** per child for the train fare.

Secondly, as you will be aware, **02.02.26 - 06.02.26** is the Year 4 residential. For the children who are **NOT** going on the residential, we run a week in school of curriculum enriching activities – we call this **Activities Week.**

We are still in the planning stages with this and are hoping that one of the highlights will be a visit to the Peter Ashley Activity Centre at Fort Widley amongst other opportunities.

We try our best to keep the cost of this week as low as possible whilst offering a fun filled week. The cost of this week will be a maximum of $\mathfrak{L}30$ per child - full price and all details to be confirmed. You will have the option to pay by instalments .
