Dear Parents,

We are very pleased to be able to give you some detailed arrangements for our Y6 treat trip day on **Thursday 16th July 2026** when we will be spending the day at Gunwharf Quays: cinema and bowling.

We will start the day by watching **'Toy Story 5'** at Vue cinema. The children will not be able to buy refreshments at the cinema, but they are encouraged to bring some snacks in their bags to enjoy during the film. The film will start at 10 o'clock so please can you drop off your child at **9.30am** at the drop-off point (on the Marks and Spencer side - the taxi drop-off point). Unfortunately, we have no other form of transport available on this day, but children love arriving in their friendship groups, so car sharing is a great option for this day out.

After the cinema, we will head over to Hollywood Bowl for an unlimited hour of bowling and lunch at the bowling alley, which is included in the price. A form will be sent home for you to choose your child's meal so that it can be ordered in advance.

Please collect your child from the same point at **2.30pm** (on the Marks and Spencer side/the taxi drop-off point). Please can we ask that you are patient when dropping and collecting your child as previous experience has shown us that this drop off area will be very busy from all the cars waiting?

This trip is non-uniform. Children may wear their own clothes for the trip, but please ensure they are wearing flat shoes with enclosed toes and a back. The bowling centre requires the children to wear shoes that meet these requirements for health and safety reasons, trainers are ideal.

The cost of the cinema, bowling and lunch, will be a total of **£10.70** per child. Please give permission and pay for this day out on the Arbor app.

If your child needs an inhaler, then please ensure that they have one either at school already or with them on the day.

As a reminder, when we are on this trip, we are representing Meon Junior School and therefore we are expecting a high standard of behaviour. We hope that this will be the case and make for an enjoyable and memorable end to their Y6 experience.
