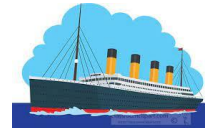

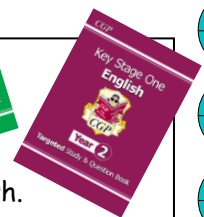
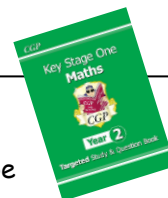
Titanic

In Year 2, homework books will be given out on a Friday and will need to be returned by the following Friday. This will be on a weekly rotation of Maths and English.

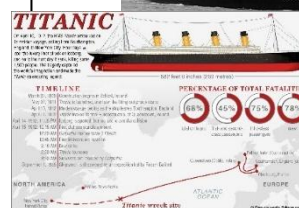
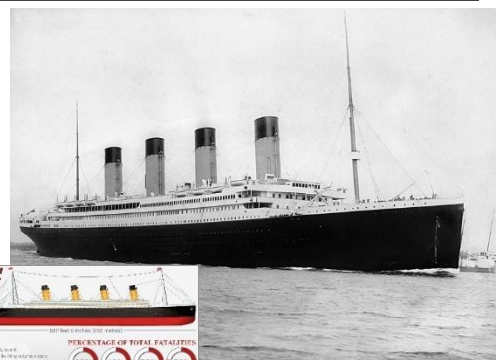
In addition to this, all pupils will have a new home reading book which they must have in school every day. Home readers will be changed every **Thursday**.

For your child's half term home learning we would like you to choose one of the following Titanic themed projects. These will be due in on **Friday 27th February 2026**.

- Create a map to show the planned journey for Titanic (Geography)
- Create an information poster to show the different facts you have learnt about the Titanic (History)
- Design or make a 3D Titanic (DT)
- Design and make a ticket to board the Titanic (Art).
- Research different jobs on board (Computing)



Developing lifelong learners:

English

In English this half term, we will be learning to write an information leaflet all about the Titanic. Alongside this, the children will be learning about statements, homophones and spelling words in the past tense.

Maths

In Maths this half term, children will be learning about shape. They will be identifying and discussing the characteristics of 2D and 3D shapes. After this, we will be moving on to fractions. Children will be recognising and identifying a $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a shape and quantity.

Topics covered this half term:

History - Children will be learning about the Titanic and why this was a significant historical event.

Science - This half term we will be investigating and exploring the world of science during Science Week!

RE - The children will be learning about the Easter Story.

Computing - In Computing, the children will be learning about programming a robot and debugging.

Art - The children will be learning about observational drawing. They will be focusing on the artist Edward King and looking at his paintings of Milton Locks.

PSHE - In this subject, children will be learning all about being healthy. They will be looking at healthy choices, having a balanced diet and dealing with different emotions.
