- Art: Sketch an interpretation of the Baobab Tree (The tree of life)




### P.E Kit reminder:

Developing lifelong learners:



English

In English this half term, the children will be using the book Lila and The Secret of Rain. We will be using this text to write a diary. We will then move on to write instructions on how to make an African mask. Alongside this the children will be developing their writing skills, such as using conjunctions, expanded noun phrases as well as learning to spelling longer words that follow particular spelling patterns.

Maths

In Maths we will be revising Number through place value, addition and subtraction. At the end of the half term, we will be moving on to measurement involving positional language, length and height.

Topics covered this half term:

Science - This half term we will be looking at how animals have different offspring and how they change over time. Please could you email or bring in a photo of your child as a baby by Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> ready for our first science lesson!

Art - This half term we will be exploring 3D art using clay.

Geography - The children will be comparing two countries, the UK and Kenya.
