

Writing

- ★ **Speeches:** children are learning speech writing skills through our climate change stimulus. They then will be writing a speech on a topic they are passionate about.
- ★ **Balanced argument:** we will be exploring whether children should receive homework as a balanced argument before the children write their own based on mobile phone use.

Home Maths:

Useful activities to complete at home:

- Reading a clock and calculating how long until they leave for school etc
- Working out money and calculating change

- identifying shapes in their environment and using correct mathematical vocabulary to discuss them
- Noticing maths in everyday life
- Quizzing on multiplication facts e.g. times tables

Home Reading:

Children should be reading at home at least 3 times a week. This is vital for practising reading at speed, especially at this time of year.


Homework:
