# HOME LEARNING IDEAS

Below are some optional learning ideas to engage your children in the subjects they are learning about in school.

### Geography

Mini Fact File - Write 5 facts about one informal settlement somewhere in the world. (E.g. Rocinha in Rio de Janeiro.)

Picture Research - Find 2-3 pictures of informal settlements (e.g. favelas in Brazil, slums in India) and write down 3 things you notice about the homes, the environment, or how people live.

**Comparison Task** - Draw your own home and then draw a house you've seen in an informal settlement. Label the differences.

#### Science

**Moon Diary -** Spend a week looking at the moon each night (if possible). Draw what it looks like and notice how its shape changes.

Planet Research - Choose a planet and make a short fact poster about it. Include: size, temperature, one fun fact.

**Space Art** – Create a picture of our solar system (you could draw, paint, or make a collage). Label each planet.

**Astronaut Challenge** – Write 5 things you would need to pack if you were going to space and explain why.
