Geography

Mini Eco-Challenges

(One Per Day/Week)

Examples:

- Turn off all lights for 1 hour: record what you did instead.
- Use no single-use plastic for a day—write or draw what you used instead.
- Create a meal using only local or leftover ingredients.

DIY Upcycled Craft Project

- Make a bird feeder from a milk jug.
- Design a pencil holder from old tin cans.
- Create an eco superhero using only recycled materials.

Science

Design an Ideal Pet (Adaptation & Needs) Invent a new animal and describe:

- What it eats
- How it moves
- Its habitat
- How it's adapted to survive

Build a Body: Create a Human Anatomy Model - Use playdough, pasta, cardboard, or recycled items to build parts of the human body.

- Digestive system with labeled parts.
- Skeleton using cotton buds or straws.
- Heart model using plastic bottles and tubes.
